As in the arcade version, Sega Saturn "Virtua Fighters" can choose to either go head-to-head with a friend, or fight their way through a tournament with each character.

Some of the most popular Virtua Fighters include:

Lau has an amazing arsenal of moves which -- when used with precision timing and skill -- qualify him for loads of style points. Lau, like his daughter, Pai, is one of the game's fastest characters, while his throws do a great deal of damage. Use his Renshin Tenkan Kyaku move to surprise the unwitting.

Pai A favorite of beginners, Pai has speed and agility, plus a number of nasty throws which leave her opponents gaping in surprise and pain. Unlike her father Lau, Pai has learned that the best defense is strong offense: she can grab her opponent's attacks and throw them to the ground! She is also hard to get in close on, as her sweep must be blocked low, but her Hien Toukyaku must be blocked high. In addition, her stomp attack has a fairly high success rate. As a handicap, try playing her without her rapid punch moves, and concentrate on throws instead!

Jacky is perhaps one of the best all-around characters, with high rankings in speed, agility and power, plus a wide array of brutal combos. He also possesses some of the most brutal recovery moves, which will make his opponents think twice about sweeping or standing behind him. His stomp attack is almost impossible to avoid!

Although less powerful than her towheaded brother, Jacky, Sarah is his equal in agility and speed, and is almost as quick with the stomp attack. Her knee attacks are formidable, but leave her vulnerable when missed. Use her Double-Step Knee to sucker in opponents who like to move in on "missed" attacks!

Virtua Fighter's revolutionary technology features polygon graphics and ever-changing 3-D perspectives that breathe life-like motion into the characters. The camera zooms in and out to give players the best point of view from every fighting angle; an instant replay feature gives yet another perspective, letting the winner bask in the final K.O.
